



# HEALTH RECORD REQUIREMENTS

**Assalamualikum Parents:**

**Physical exams** are required for all students entering **Preschool (3&4 yrs. old), Kindergarten, 6th and 9th grade** and students transferring from an out-of-state school into Illinois for the first time.

**DUE IN OFFICE ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL (AUGUST 09, 2018).**

- 1. Certificate of Child Health Exam:** Physical examinations must be dated after August 1<sup>st</sup> of the prior school year. All portions of the exam must be completed, included parent signature, in order for the physical to be valid.

**2. Immunizations:** complete record of all **required** immunizations including month, day, and year, and signed by a nurse or doctor:

- **Dtap Vaccine:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.)- 4 doses at correct intervals. **K-12:** 4 or more doses at correct intervals.
- **Tdap Booster:** 6-12 students must show proof of ONE Tdap booster regardless of the interval since the last DTaP, DT or Td.
- **Polio Vaccine:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 3 doses at correct intervals. **K-12:** 4 or more doses at correct intervals.
- **HIB Vaccine:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) Has received the primary series of Hib vaccine according to the Hib vaccination schedule or a single dose of Hib vaccine between 15-59 months of age.
- **Hepatitis B Vaccine:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 3 doses at correct intervals. **6-12:** 3 doses at correct intervals.
- **Varicella (Chicken Pox):** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 1 dose on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday. **K-12:** 2 doses at correct intervals.
- **MMR Vaccine -Measles, Mumps and Rubella:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) 1 dose on or after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday but prior to 24 months of age. **K-12:** 2 doses at correct intervals.
- **Invasive Pneumococcal Vaccine:** Pre-K (3 & 4 yrs.) Has received the primary series of pneumococcal conjugate vaccine according to the vaccine schedule or a single dose of pneumococcal vaccine between 24-59 months of age.
- **Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine:** Grade 6, 7 & 8: One dose received on or after 10<sup>th</sup> birthday. **Grade 12: 2** doses received unless the first dose was administered after 16 years of age ***(No proof of immunity allowed)***.

**3. Dental Exams:** are required for students entering **KG, 2 and 6 grades**. **DUE IN OFFICE BY MARCH 15, 2019.**

**4. Vision Exam** is required for **KG, 2 and 8 grade** students and **all students new to Illinois schools**. An eye Doctor, (ophthalmologist or a licensed optometrist) must perform the required eye exam. **DUE IN OFFICE BY OCTOBER 1, 2018.**
