Therefore, we are allowing those students (who are without water or power) to come dressed in appropriate casual, following the guidelines below. We will be monitoring these guidelines, and students who do not follow them will be sent home or parents will be called.

### **Casual Guidelines**

No short shorts or short dresses/skirts.

No spaghetti straps or halter tops, low-cut shirts, short tops with midriff showing, see-through or muscle shirts.

No jeans which are ripped or with holes.

No shirt or clothing with offensive language or innuendo, double meaning, crude phrases or hats (including caps).

Shoes allowed: Closed shoes including tennis shoes, Crocs and closed-back sandals.

**Not allowed: flip-flops or any open back sandal or slide sandals (for safety reasons).**
