In response to the many and varied needs of our MACS families, the MACS Business Office, with the support of the Superintendent, has been investigating ways to streamline admissions, re-enrollment, tuition payment, and the tuition collection process.

The Mecklenburg Area Catholic Schools is pleased to announce **we will be using an online admissions and enrollment system for the 2019 – 2020 school year.**

We will be partnering with School Admin for the admissions and re-enrollment process and FACTS Management for the processing and collection of our families' tuition payments for the 2019 – 2020 school year. By moving to an online admissions and tuition management system, MACS joins other Catholic and independent schools utilizing such services to better serve our families.

What does this mean for parents?

1. **Admissions:** New student and/or sibling parents will now complete all applications online. Applications are now live (January 7) and can be completed by [clicking here](#).
2. **Re-enrollment:** Current student parents will re-enroll their current students for the 2019-20 through the online system. At this time, there is nothing for you to complete. More details and information will be sent to you electronically in February.
3. **Billing:** the 2019-20 school year billing will also be online. More details and information will be sent to you electronically in February in conjunction with the re-enrollment process.
4. **Tuition Assistance:** to apply for tuition assistance, each family must complete a separate Tuition Assistance application through FACTS Management – Grant & Aid which can be found by [clicking here](#).
