"WINTER WONDERLAND"

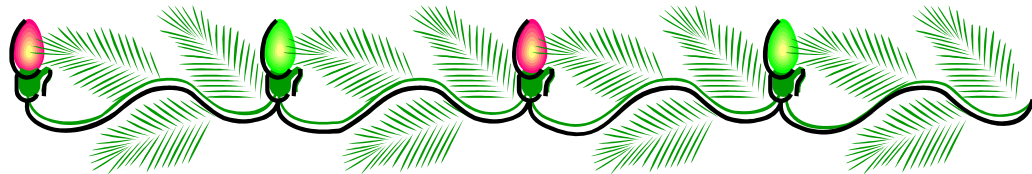
