MVCS, as a ministry of Faith Baptist Church, invites all of its friends to attend a special revival meeting service with Evangelist Wil Rice.

Tuesday night is designated as School Night. Classes will be competing with each other to see which group has the highest percentage of their total enrollment. The classes with the highest percentage will receive a pizza party at school the following Monday.

Here is how you can help your child win the pizza party:

1. All children in the classes will be asked to stand for a count to be taken.
2. Any parents or grandparents present will be asked to stand with their child and will be added to the class's total. This total will be **doubled**. If the parents or grandparents have more than one child in MVCS, then they may stand up and be counted for each of their children.
3. If any student brought a visitor, they will be asked to stand up and will be added to the class's total. This count will **triple**. *Visitors may only count for one student.*
