BACKGROUND

Dominic Murray attended Monsignor McClancy Memorial High School from 2005 - 2009. On October 5, 2009 three months after his high school graduation, Dominic suffered a sudden cardiac arrest while playing basketball at Farmingdale State College. He was only 17 years old when his life ended. When Dominic's SCA happened no one knew what to do. His signs went unrecognized by all around him. No one performed CPR right away. No one immediately retrieved the AED and used it. What happened to Dominic is not rare and it can be prevented. After Dominic's tragic death, his mother Melinda Murray started a grassroots campaign to raise awareness on sudden cardiac arrest and sudden cardiac death to prevent another loss of a child to such a preventable tragedy. The Dominic A. Murray 21 Memorial Foundation (DomHeart21) is committed to expand CPR-AED training, public access to lifesaving automated external defibrillators (AED) and heart screenings so that no other family loses a child for lack of screening, training or life-saving equipment. The Dominic A. Murray Memorial Scholarship honors Dominic's character as a student first, an athlete and a compassionate human being. Dominic is forever a McClancy Crusader. SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

The \$2,100 Dominic A. Murray Scholarship will be awarded to a student-athlete participating in a McClancy sports program with a minimum 85 GPA. Selections are made based on a written essay, academic achievement, community service, two letters of recommendation and interview. *** Letters of recommendation must be typed on official letterhead (1 must be from a McClancy teacher, 1 must be from an organization where the student performed community service.)**
