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### News From The Principal

Dear Saint Agnes Families,

The first trimester of learning has drawn to a close and your child(ren)'s report card(s) should be enclosed in your family's blue BEE folder. Please spend some time with each child privately in review of their personal progress-to-date as indicated on their report card. It is healthy to identify areas where acknowledgement of their accomplishments and hard work should be given and where they should concentrate their focus for growth during the second trimester. Be mindful and have individual conversations with siblings, and be intentional to avoid comparisons between them. Allow for celebration of each child's unique gifts and talents. Your kind support of and respectful partnership with our teachers and support staff is also appreciated.

As we move forward in trimester two, be aware that there are only 17 instructional days before the Christmas break. Students' attendance at school for the entirety of the day is essential! For our middle school students in grades 6, 7, and 8, they will have mid-year exams in December. This is an opportunity for students to learn how to incrementally review and study material for a lengthier assessment that may require them to apply learned knowledge, synthesize or analyze information, recall prior learning and more. Students and parents should look for the schedule of exams and for study guides that are posted digitally and should begin preparing well in advance for exams.

Finally, the faculty and staff of Saint Agnes School wish you a safe and happy Thanksgiving holiday!

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## STAR Math Results

This year, Saint Agnes is using the STAR Math assessment to incrementally assess student math learning in grades 3-6. Enclosed in today's BEE, those students in grades 3, 4, 5, and 6 will have a parent letter and a three page report to show their child's benchmark score and subsequent score after the first trimester of math instruction. The final page of this report shows a nice line plot of the scores. Minimally, we will give the assessment each trimester to inform progress as well as next steps. 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## Inclement Weather Schedule

### EMERGENCY SCHOOL CLOSING

On days of inclement weather, parents are asked to listen to one of the local television or radio stations for possible announcements about school closings. Messages will, whenever possible, also be sent through the REACH Alert System.

One of two announcements will probably be made:

- 1) All Jefferson County Catholic Schools will be closed.
- 2) All Jefferson County Catholic Schools are on a delayed schedule.

**For Saint Agnes, a delayed schedule means that students are in the classroom at 9:50 am and school instruction begins at 10:00 am.**

**Students may arrive at 9:15 am and 9:50 am on these days. The bus begin pickups at 9:00 am. Saint Agnes will again utilize *Distance Learning* as a way to make up some school days.**

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## Distance Learning

Saint Agnes School faculty and families look forward to enjoying a snow day or two this year! With the prospect of an "eventful" winter with regard to weather, Saint Agnes School will again utilize Distance Learning (DL) as one way to make up some inclement weather days. The school administration will use discretion when deciding when to implement a DL day and asks for your flexibility and support to help these days run smoothly.

Each grade level, K-8, has prepared and will communicate by Dec. 1st, their plans for these days. Some grades include paper packets of instructions and/or work for students to complete and families or caregivers to help implement from home. Others, particularly our Middle School teachers, will communicate digitally through email, Gaggie, and/or Google classroom. When you receive your child(ren's) plan, please take a moment to review the it in advance of a DL day so things run smoothly. Completed and returned work will be reviewed and is proof positive of "attendance" during a Distance Learning day. Thank you for your patience and teamwork on this.

\*Application date window is EARLIER! Dec. 15, 2017 to Feb. 28, 2018 is the NEW and EARLIER application window. Application available online on/after Dec. 15th: [www.ceflou.org](http://www.ceflou.org). The application fee is \$25.00.

\*Last year's tax info now used. 2016 federal income tax return and 2016 W-2 information will be used for the 2018-19 school year application. No more stress or pressure to get your current year's taxes filed first.
