As I consider our mission in the context of our recent Parent, Teacher, Student conferences, I want to thank our families, faculty and students for all of the open dialogue and important conversations that occurred during our fall conferences last week. Conferences provide an opportunity to look at progress-to-date and to plan for intentional and continued growth. Oftentimes these check-ins allow all of us the opportunity to analyze and reflect on what we are doing to support student learning and growth in our faith-based Catholic school.
