SAVE THE DATE

Save the date for our first annual Back-to-School Liturgy, Social, and Supply Drop-Off for all, PK – 8th grade. We are excited for the opportunity to celebrate that Saint Agnes School is a ministry of Saint Agnes Parish. As the largest ministry, we are supported by the Parish not only financially, but through our relationships as a faith community. Therefore, Saint Agnes School students and their families are invited to an important back-to-school event on SUNDAY, AUGUST 13th at and following the 11:30AM liturgy. To kick off the festivities, families are invited to attend mass on August 13th at Saint Agnes Church, with a special celebration held at the 11:30AM Sunday liturgy to kick off our school theme and to remind us that our Step-by-Step Stewardship Program is a way of life within the parish and school. Choir members are invited to sing in the choir with Mr. Edlin and Ms. Duncan. We are also excited that our Student Council Officers will present the Stewardship Banners at the mass. Fr. David will also give a special blessing to our students, families, faculty, and staff, as we begin this school year. This liturgy will be in place of the evening prayer service held in past school years, as our goal is to provide all families with an opportunity to experience an all school liturgy. Following the liturgy, families will proceed over to the school. Our PTO will host an expanded "ICE CREAM SOCIAL" with ice cream, a light food/snack menu, and beverages and invite everyone to attend. Beginning at 12:45, all homeroom classrooms will be open so that students, accompanied by their parents, may meet their teachers and drop off their school supplies as they visit their classrooms. Students whose last names begin with A-L will begin in the Parish Center visiting with friends and enjoying something to eat from 12:45-1:15 while students whose last names begin with M-Z visit classrooms. Then, from 1:15-1:45, students whose last names begin with A-L will visit classrooms and those M-Z will enjoy something to eat. Our faculty and staff will be on hand until 2:00/2:15PM to be certain that all families have had a chance visit and drop supplies in the classrooms.

FEES, FORMS, DOCUMENTATION

Saint Agnes School follows federal and state education laws and protocols. In order for students to begin attending Saint Agnes School on August 16th, 2017, all fees must be current, and all requested forms/documentation must be complete and on file with the school office. These items include: birth certificate, social security card, baptismal certificate, physical exam form, immunization, and eye exam. UNIFORMS

School uniforms may be purchased at Shaheen's Department Store. As mentioned this past Spring, only navy blue polos are allowed to be worn by students in grades 5-8th beginning August 2017 forward. Also note that while students in grade 8 were offered a hoodie as special piece of 8th grade spirit wear, they may not wear the hoodie as their uniform sweatshirt. Navy non-hoodie uniform sweatshirts and the navy half-zip fleece are what should be worn during the school day, please. This was stated on the 8th grade spirit wear order form. Students may, however, wear the hoodie on casual dress days and designated spirit wear days. Finally, please note that socks should be white, navy, or black without any logos. Socks may be crew socks or socks that cover the ankle. Thank you for communicating with your children about this and for supporting the school in this way.

The last day for Summer Care is Friday, August 11th. There will not be summer care on Mon. or Tues. Aug. 14 & 15th as we transition into the school year. After School Care begins on the first day of school for students in 1st-6th grades.

SAFE ENVIRONMENT
