### **Last School Day for Grades K-7**

Dismissal for K-7 students will be at 1:30 p.m. following the 12:30 p.m. Mass next Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. Report cards will be handed out in the Church by the teachers after the Mass. I hope that many of our families can join us for this final All-school liturgy to celebrate the 2017-2018 school year.

Please be aware that final copies of report cards are not sent via e-mail this final quarter. A final copy will be given to each student. Final grades are not posted on Rediker so the grades you see at the end of the year will not appear complete. All finances must be current for students to receive their report card. This includes: tuition, past due Late Day accounts, lunch accounts, SCRIP Buyout and any fines due in classes. Service Hours for families must also be completed and turned in by tomorrow, May 18<sup>th</sup>. Each family was asked to give 20 hours of service throughout the school year. Five of these hours can be community service. Families who have not fulfilled their service hour requirement will be charged \$20 per hour or a total of \$400 for hours not completed. Report cards will not be distributed to families who do not respond to this requirement. Students will be receiving blank envelopes. Fees due for this service requirement must be paid with cash or a cashier's check.
