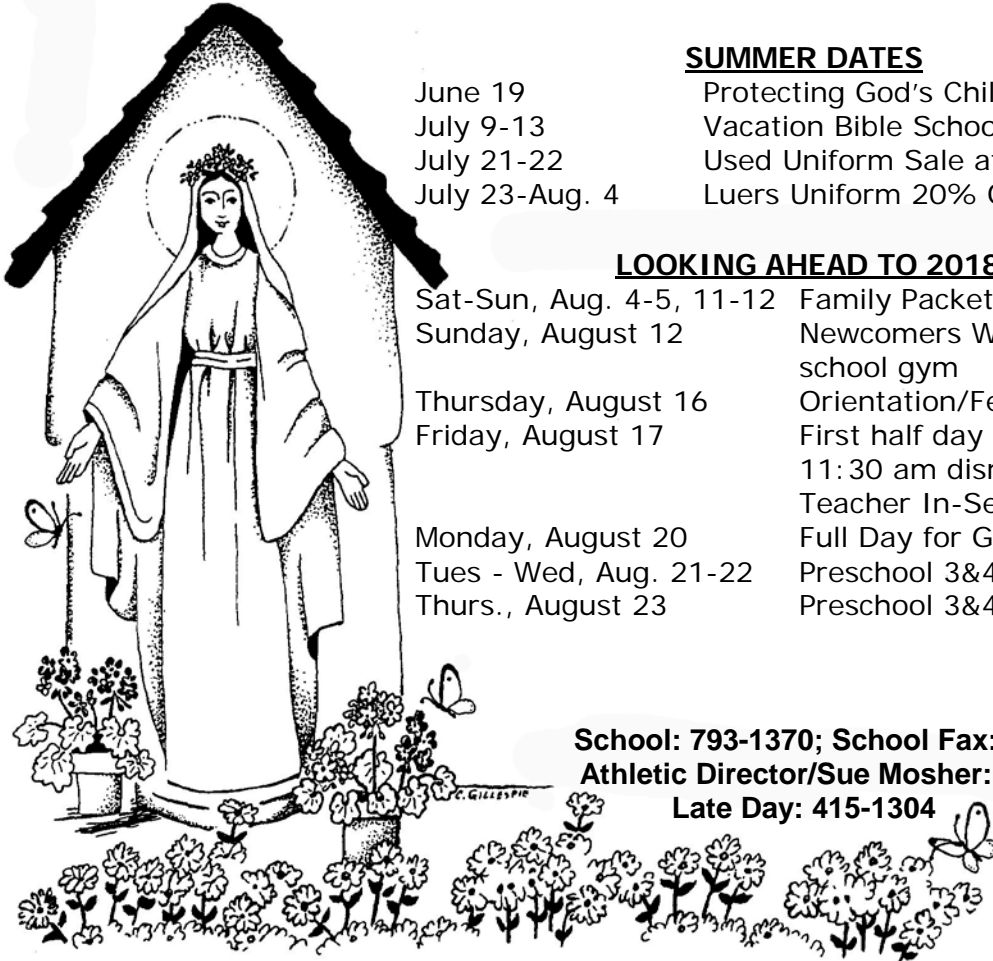

## **MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

Dear St. Agnes School Parents,

### **Changes for the 2018-2019 School Year**

Plans are already under way for a new school year before we end the current year. Yesterday at our Awards Assembly we honored two teachers and one aide who will be leaving us at the end of this school year. We are grateful for the gifts that Mrs. Beth LaFata, Mrs. Marissa Hennessy and Mrs. Tami Dillon have shared with our school community. Mrs. LaFata, as the school counselor, has touched the lives of all of our students and families as she has held "life skills" classes with all grades and connected many families to community services to support various needs of students. Mrs. Hennessy has given our students a new appreciation for the Spanish Language with her spirited approach to the teaching of Spanish to K-8. Mrs. Dillon has brought her artistic talents to the many displays on the second floor and supported teachers in multiple ways. We will miss all three of these teachers and the joy they brought to daily life here at St. Agnes.

There are two positions and changes that have only come to light in the last week and a half. On the day of the End of the Year Class parties, Mrs. Renee Osipov approached me to let me know that she was resigning her position here at St. Agnes to spend more time with her family. Mrs. Osipov, as many will know, has been on a maternity leave. Mrs. Osipov has been an outstanding first grade teacher and has had a wonderful rapport with students and parents. She will be missed.

The second change is a difficult one as it is happening due to a "Reduction in Force." We have waited as long as we could to make the decision about preschool teachers for the coming year. Right now there are only nine 3 year old pre-school children signed up for the 3 year old class of preschoolers. Only 3 of those are full time. One is four days a week, one may not be ready to come next year, one is three mornings a week and the other three are signed up for Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. It is not possible to pay a third teacher in pre-school with this small amount of children. We hope there may be some growth in this class over the summer months.

Mrs. Kon, whose certification is for grades 6-12, and who would need to take 5 years of courses to become certified for continuing in preschool, has been asked to not continue teaching in the daily preschool program. However, we hope she will return as an aide, a substitute and/or just to visit. Mrs. Kon has been with St. Agnes School for sixteen years, 10 as a classroom aide and 6 working in preschool as a teacher. She has been an outstanding teacher in the preschool program. Her creativity, enthusiasm as a teacher, deep faith, and joy that she brings to her classroom daily have blessed us all. We are so grateful for her dedication and commitment to St. Agnes and the preschool program. Mrs. Kon's daily presence will be missed. If you wish to greet Mrs. Kon, please stop by her classroom to say thank you any time tomorrow...before school, during the morning or afternoon, lunch time, after school...or you may want to write her a note of thanks, especially if you have had a student in her class. Again, we are very grateful for Mrs. Kon's presence among us and express our deepest gratitude to her. May she be blessed with God's peace and love.

The two teachers remaining for pre-school will be Mrs. Andrea Rupnik for 4 year olds and Mrs. Amy Alderman who will teach the 3 year olds and an overflow of four years olds. We believe that this is possible as there will be days when the number of three year olds are small. The aide in the classroom will be assisting with the varied needs. We will be looking also to increase the academic expectations with the three year olds next year, which would have been happening if Mrs. Kon was still with us.

Our current number for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade next year is at 19 students which is what we began with this school year for their first grade. Due to this size, there will be one second grade

for the 2018-2019 school year. The first grade that will have 23 students will remain one class. Both second grade teachers will remain on staff. Ms. Kathi Keane will teach the second grade and Mrs. Jessica Steinkrueger will move to the 5<sup>th</sup> grade to teach Math, Science and Religion. This is the level where Mrs. Steinkrueger started here seven years ago. Her certification, as a teacher, covers this grade level.

Mrs. Meghann Newman, who will be having her first child, a girl, will take a maternity leave until October 22<sup>nd</sup>. She will return to the Resource position at that time. We will not replace her during this time as it takes awhile, in a new school year, for the teachers to become acquainted with individual student needs. Challenge classes also begin in October.

### **A Grateful Heart**

Thank you to all for the time, energy, spirit, talents, and gifts you have given to this 2017-2018 school year. Thank you for working together to build a strong school community. Fr. Bob, St. Agnes teachers and I are grateful to all of our parents who served on our School Board, advising and planning for our school, and this year, in particular, preparing for the State and Diocesan evaluation, to the Parents' Club members who support varied activities that bring our school community together, to the many parents who sat on the Enrollment and Marketing, Annual Fund, Long- Range Planning, Magic-Match, Grant Writing, Sports and Technology Committees. We appreciate, also, the many who have been involved in service within the school as room parents, library volunteers, cafeteria workers, playground supervisors, readers, drivers, Scholastic Bowl and Chess Club leaders, coaches, the "Spirit" Newsletter, the annual auction and varied class, school and Parish activities. Our volunteers in all of these groups numbered over 300 this year! Thank you, too, to our many teachers who help with extra committee work and after school events and activities! What tremendous support you have given to our 2017-2018 school year. Thank you for helping one another and others to "Catch our Spirit" at St. Agnes.

### **Thanks to Room Parents**

Monday of this week, our classes celebrated their end of the year parties. It was a fun and spirited day for all with the rain clearing before classes went outside! Thank you to our Room parents and teachers for planning the creative activities for our children, not just yesterday but throughout this school year. 




