

## BOYS Uniform Requirements

<b><i>Pants/Shorts</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Gray pants or gray shorts with belt loops (Only Pre-K students are allowed to wear elastic waistbands.)</li> <li>➤ Extra-curricular uniforms must also be appropriate length.</li> </ul>
<b><i>Shirts</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Pre-K boys have their own maroon polo T-shirt - the <b>gray tshirt will be phased out after the 2019-2020 school year</b></li> <li>➤ Gray shirts with St. Cletus emblem (K – 5)</li> <li>➤ Solid white oxford shirt with St. Cletus emblem (6-7)</li> <li>➤ <b>Shirts tucked in at all times</b></li> <li>➤ Solid white or gray T-shirt, (sleeves must not extended past outer shirt’s sleeves)</li> <li>➤ During cold weather, long sleeve white shirts will be permitted</li> </ul>
<b><i>Sweaters/Jackets/Coat</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ School sweater, windbreaker, or sweatshirts are required</li> <li>➤ In cold weather, heavy outer coats may be worn over a St. Cletus sweatshirt, sweater, or jacket while outdoors. No apparel advertising other elementary, middle, secondary school or university may be worn.</li> <li>➤ The St. Cletus School P. E. Department sells the “St. Cletus Spirit T-Shirt” which can be worn on Tuesday, Spirit Days, in place of the normal uniform shirt.</li> <li>➤ <b>The hooded sweatshirts with pouch pocket are no longer allowed.</b></li> </ul>
<b><i>Shoes/Socks/Belts</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Pre-K 3 will wear <b>WHITE</b> Velcro shoes</li> <li>➤ Pre-K 4 will wear <b>BLACK</b> Velcro shoes</li> <li>➤ K-2 will wear <b>BLACK</b> leather tie shoes, no canvas</li> <li>➤ 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> Solid black tie shoes, no colored bands or brand labels – <b>LOW TOPS ONLY</b></li> <li>➤ Solid white socks (crew, tube). No stripes or logos except spirit socks.</li> <li>➤ Black or grey belt</li> </ul>
<b><i>Jewelry</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Watches only – No necklaces, bracelets, earrings, or rings</li> <li>➤ <i>Body piercing and tattoos are not allowed</i></li> </ul>
<b><i>Hair</i></b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Boys must be clean-shaven</li> <li>➤ Hair – Hairstyles must be neat and clean and natural at all times</li> <li>➤ Hairstyles and haircuts which are faddish and deemed inappropriate by the administration must be modified within a specific time limit set by the administration</li> <li>➤ Hair must be worn off of the face and out of the eyes</li> <li>➤ Hair, when pulled down and extended, must be above the ears, the eyebrows, and the shirt collar. Shaved or partially shaved cuts are not allowed</li> <li>➤ Curly hair, when pulled down and extended, must be above the ears, the eyebrows, and the shirt collar.</li> <li>➤ Hair must not be bleached, streaked, dyed, highlighted, or altered in any manner</li> <li>➤ Severe haircuts and styles that are disruptive to the learning environment are not allowed</li> </ul>

## GIRLS Uniform Requirements

<b>Smocks/Bloomers</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All Pre-K girls will either wear the St. Cletus smock and bloomers or skort and maroon polo shirt which are available at Skobel's in Gretna.</li> </ul>
<b>Blouses/Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ White uniform blouse-short-sleeved, pointed or round collar (K – 5)</li> <li>➤ Solid white oxford shirt with St. Cletus emblem (6 – 7)</li> <li>➤ Solid white t-shirt, undershirt (Sleeves must not extend past outer shirt's sleeves)</li> <li>➤ During cold weather, long sleeve white shirts will be permitted</li> <li>➤ Undergarments should not be visible at any time</li> <li>➤ <b>Blouses/Shirts must be tucked in at all times.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Jumpers/Shorts/Skirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ SCS Plaid jumpers (grades K – 5); SCS Plaid skirts (grades 6 – 7)</li> <li>➤ SCS Plaid walking shorts with the uniform blouse and a black belt – <i>Must have belt loops on the shorts</i> (grades K – 5)</li> <li>➤ Jumper and skirt length should be no shorter than the top of the knee</li> <li>➤ Extra-curricular uniforms must also be appropriate length.</li> </ul>
<b>Sweaters/Jackets/Coats</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ School sweater, windbreaker, or sweatshirts are required</li> <li>➤ In cold weather, heavy outer coats may be worn over a St. Cletus sweatshirt, sweater, or jacket while outdoors. No apparel advertising other elementary, middle, or secondary or university school may be worn.</li> <li>➤ The St. Cletus School P. E. Department sells the "St. Cletus Spirit T-Shirt" which can be worn on Tuesday, Spirit Days, in place of the normal uniform shirt.</li> <li>➤ <b>The hooded sweatshirts with pouch pocket are no longer allowed.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Shoes/Socks/Belts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Pre-K 3 will wear <b>WHITE</b> Velcro shoes</li> <li>➤ Pre-K 4 will wear <b>BLACK</b> Velcro shoes</li> <li>➤ K-2 will wear <b>BLACK</b> leather tie shoes, no canvas</li> <li>➤ 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> Solid black tie shoes, no colored bands or brand labels – <b>LOW TOPS ONLY</b></li> <li>➤ Solid white socks (crew, tube). No stripes or logos except spirit socks</li> <li>➤ Black or gray belt</li> </ul>
<b>Leggings, Tights, Sweatpants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ In cold weather, girls may wear any solid (no writing or logos other than SCS) gray, black, white, or maroon ankle length leggings/legwarmers, tights or sweatpants. <b>No yoga or PJ pants</b></li> </ul>
<b>Jewelry</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ A watch, a single pair of earrings in the lower lobe of the ear (<b>post or stud only</b>), no necklaces, bracelets, or rings</li> <li>➤ Body piercing and tattoos are not allowed</li> </ul>
<b>Other Grooming Issues</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ No fingernail polish, false nails or make up allowed</li> </ul>
<b>Hair</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Hairstyles must be neat and clean and natural at all times</li> <li>➤ Hairstyles and haircuts which are faddish and deemed inappropriate by the administration must be modified within a specific time limit set by the administration</li> <li>➤ Hair must be worn off of the face and out of the eyes</li> <li>➤ Hair may not be bleached, streaked, dyed, highlighted, or altered in any manner. Any hair extensions must be the same color as the natural hair and no adornments may be added (such as beads, threads etc.)</li> </ul>

## Uniforms for Physical Education Class

<b>Grades 1-7</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All students “dress out” for P.E. class.</li> </ul>
<b>Grades 1-2</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The P.E. grade is <u>not impacted</u> by whether or not these students wear the proper P.E. uniform.</li> <li>➤ Girls are <u>encouraged</u> to wear maroon modesty P.E. shorts under their jumper on P. E. days.</li> <li>➤ Boys are <u>encouraged</u> to wear the gray uniform shorts on P.E. days. Boys who wear long gray uniform pants to school can wear maroon P.E. shorts under the pants, or wear biking shorts under the pants, and then take the pants off at P. E. time, putting the maroon shorts on over the biking shorts.</li> </ul>
<b>Grades 3-7</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The P.E. grade is <u>impacted</u> by whether or not these students wear the proper P.E. uniform.</li> <li>➤ Maroon P.E. shorts with the St. Cletus emblem.</li> <li>➤ Gray uniform shorts (Boys and allowed to keep their gray uniform shorts on for P.E.)</li> <li>➤ Plaid uniform shorts (Girls are allowed to keep their plaid uniform shorts on for P.E.)</li> <li>➤ White uniform shirt (Middle school students are allowed to wear a solid white t-shirt <u>under</u> their uniform shirt and take off their uniform shirt <u>during P.E. class.</u></li> <li>➤ Tennis shoes (Low-cut- no high or three quarter tops)</li> <li>➤ White socks</li> <li>➤ In cold weather, all students may wear any solid colored (no writing or logos other than SCS) sweat pant (gray, black, white or maroon) over their shorts during <u>P.E. class.</u> St. Cletus sweat pants are available at Skobel’s School Uniforms.</li> </ul>

***If a student is improperly dressed, consequences for his or her grade level will be administered. The principal is the final authority of what is appropriate dress.***
