## SCS Sports Information



All students interested in trying out for a sports team in the 2019-2020 school year must complete the *Archdiocese of Miami Athletic Release & Physical Evaluation* forms over the summer. These three ADoM forms can be found as a single PDF document on the St. Coleman Website under Athletics. The first two pages are an insurance waiver and a health history form, to be completed and signed by the parent, and the third page is a physical form which must be completed and signed by your child's doctor and ***dated after June 1, 2019***. These forms are separate from the blue and yellow state health forms which are kept on file in the front office. Students need to turn in the ADoM sports forms to the Athletic Directors, Mrs. DeLoach or Mrs. Faber, **before** trying out for any SCS sports team next school year or starting cheerleading practice in the fall.
