Dear Parent/Guardian:

Nazareth Regional High School policy mandates that ALL new entrants must submit all of the following in order to attend school.

- ◆ A completed Nazareth Regional High School New Admission Medical form. This form must be SIGNED and MECHANICALLY STAMPED by the physician. This exam must have been done within 12 months of admission.
- ◆ An up to date Immunization History, which must include the following:
 - 3 Doses of Diphtheria vaccine – DPT or Dt or Td
 - 4 Doses of Polio vaccine – OPV or IPV
 - 2 Doses of MMR vaccine
 - 3 Doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
 - 2 Doses of Varicella-VZV or documentation of disease
 - 1 Dose of Tdap
 - 1-2 Doses Meningococcal vaccine

The attached medical form must be returned to the nurse's office before **May 31st**. Keep in mind that this medical form is also necessary in order for your child to participate in any sport, so it is best to have the exam done in Spring/ Early Summer in order for the medical to remain valid for the school year. A new Medical will be required each year if your child participates in a sport. Your child ***will not*** be allowed to try out for a sport without this completed medical form.

*****BEFORE SUBMITTING THIS FORM TO THE SCHOOL NURSE, PLEASE MAKE A COPY FOR YOUR RECORDS. PLEASE RETURN THE FORM TO THE NURSE VIA MAIL USING THE ENCLOSED ENVELOPE**

The Department of Health mandates that all students have an up to date medical on file. Failure to comply will result in suspension from school.
